Suzette D. May Scholarship Fund

The Suzette D. May Scholarship Fund was established to honor the life and legacy of Suzette May, a devoted educator and faithful member of Anderson United Methodist Church (AUMC). Suzette believed deeply in the power of faith, education, and service to uplift others. This year's scholarship award will be based on the available endowed funds.

Who is Eligible:

- Must be a member or active participant of Anderson United Methodist Church for at least two years.
- Must be a 2025 high school graduate.
- Must have participated in the AUMC Higher Education Ministry College Prep Program.
- Must pursue full-time undergraduate enrollment at an accredited college or university, majoring in Education, or enrollment in a certificate or career program in Education.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must submit a college acceptance and enrollment letter.
- Must submit a 500–750 word, double-spaced essay.
- Must submit two letters of recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, or academic advisor that specifically address the applicant's academic abilities, commitment to education, and potential for success

Walter Turner Scholarship Fund

The Walter Turner Scholarship Fund honors Walter Turner, a lifelong United Methodist who valued higher education and demonstrated a passion for helping young people succeed. This scholarship supports students majoring in Business or Finance who exemplify Christian faith, leadership, and commitment to making a difference in the world. The Walter Turner Scholarship provides an award of \$3,000 to the selected recipient.

Who is Eligible:

- Must be a member of Anderson United Methodist Church.
- Must be a 2025 high school graduate.
- Must have participated in the AUMC Higher Education Ministry College Prep Program.
- Must pursue full-time undergraduate enrollment at an accredited college or university, majoring in Business or Finance.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must submit a college acceptance and enrollment letter.
- Must submit a 500–750 word, double-spaced essay.
- Must submit two letters of recommendation from individuals who have witnessed the applicant's personal growth, character, and experiences throughout their life's journey.
